THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 9) 1942.

Order made by the Competent Authority under Regulation 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942, I hereby order as follows:—

This Order may be cited as the Defence (Paper Control) Order, 1942.
 In this Order—

"paper" means any paper other than newsprint as defined in the Defence (Newsprint Control) Orders, 1940 and 1942, and includes bags and similar receptacles made from paper.

3. Within three days from the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* every person who has in his possession or under his control any paper in excess of 10 okes in the aggregate shall complete and deliver to me a return in the form set forth in the First Schedule hereto in respect of the paper in his possession or under his control, together with a sample piece of each kind of such paper.

4. Not later than six days after the last day of each month, commencing from the month of January, 1943, any person who has in his possession or under his control any paper in excess of 10 okes in the aggregate shall complete and deliver to me a return containing the particulars set forth in the Second Schedule hereto in respect of his dealings in paper.

5.-(a) From and after the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* no person who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of paper in excess of 10 okes in the aggregate shall sell, dispose of or make use of, in any manner, any paper except under a special permit issued under my hand.

(b) Every special permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (a) hereof may contain such terms and conditions (including the price at which such paper may be sold or purchased) as may be specified therein.

6. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner may authorize in writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under any of the provisions of this Order.

7. Any person who—

- (a) contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Order ;
- (b) makes a return required to be made under this Order which is false in any material particular;
