No. 51. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1942.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATIONS 29 (2) AND 89.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulations 29 (2) and 89 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1942, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Publication of Broadcast News) Restriction Order, 1942.

2. On and from the 1st day of March, 1942, no person shall publish in any newspaper any news broadcast from any station except under and in virtue of a permit under the hand of the Public Information Officer.

3. Any permit issued under the provisions of this Order may contain such terms and conditions as the Public Information Officer may seem fit to impose.

4. Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) of clause 5 every permit issued under the provisions of this Order shall be valid for one year from the date of issue and there shall be paid in respect thereof a fee of five pounds.

5.—(1) Any person who acts in contravention of, or fails to observe or comply with, any of the provisions of this Order or any of the terms and conditions contained in any permit issued thereunder is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1942.

(2) Any permit issued to any person convicted for any offence under this Order shall be forfeited and cancelled without any refund of the fee paid therefor or of any part thereof.
