No. 545. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 9) 1942.

DELEGATION OF POWER UNDER PARAGRAPH (5) OF REGULATION 66. C. C. Woolley,

Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph (5) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942, do hereby depute the persons for the time being holding the offices designated in the second column of the Schedule hereto to exercise and perform on my behalf the powers mentioned in the first column of the said Schedule which I am empowered to exercise and perform under the provisions of paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942.

2. The Order published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 24th September, 1942, under Notification No. 361 is hereby revoked

without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

3. Nothing in this Order contained shall affect the operation and validity of previous Orders made under regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942, in force for the time being.
