No. 60. THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940 AND 1941.

NOTICE No. 59 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 7 and the substitution therefor of the following part :—

“PART 7.—RICE.

(1)	(2)	(3)
Type of Rice.	Retail Price.	Wholesale Price.
Egyptian rice ‘Mamsuh’	6 piastres per oke.	47 shillings per bag of approximately 80 okes.
Rizzoni and all other types of rice.	6½ piastres per oke.	50 shillings per bag of approximately 80 okes.

In this Part of the Schedule—

the term ‘wholesale’ means sale or purchase of rice in quantities of not less than one bag of approximately 80 okes at any one time or at any single transaction.”

B.—PART 36.—POTATOES.

The retail price is altered from 4½ piastres per oke to 5 piastres per oke.
