No. 69. THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940 AND 1941.

NOTICE No. 61 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

The Schedule is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following part:—

"PART 43.—MILK OF SHEEP OR GOATS OR ANY ADMIXTURE OF SHEEP'S MILK AND GOATS' MILK.

Milk of sheep or goats or any admixture of sheep's milk and goats' milk	Price. 6 piastres per oke.

Limitation : Where milk of sheep or goats is delivered to consumer's premises in quantities not exceeding two okes to any consumer on any one day the maximum price may be 7 piastres per oke.
