

No. 70. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1942, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Flax) Order, 1942.
2. In this Order—
“flax” means flax fibre processed before 1942 and includes tow.
3. On or before the 21st March, 1942, every person who has in his possession or under his control any flax in excess of 100 okes shall complete and deliver to me a return in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto in respect of the flax in his possession or under his control.
- 4.—(a) From and after the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* no person who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of flax in excess of the quantity mentioned in clause 2 of this Order shall make use of or shall sell or dispose of any flax to any person except under a special permit issued under my hand.
(b) Every special permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (a) hereof may contain such terms and conditions as may be specified therein.
5. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner of the District may authorize by writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under any of the provisions of this Order.
6. Any person who—
(a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order, or
(b) makes, under clause 2 of this Order, a return which is false in any material particular,
is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1942, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Beans) Order, 1942.
2. Within three days from the date of the publication of this Order every person who has in his possession or under his control any beans in excess of 800 okes shall complete and deliver to me a declaration in the form set forth in the First Schedule hereto in respect of the beans in his possession or under his control.
3. Not later than six days after the last day of each month, commencing from the month of April, 1942, any person who has in his possession or under his control

any beans in excess of 800 okes shall complete and deliver to me a return containing the particulars set forth in the Second Schedule hereto in respect of his dealings in beans.

4. Every person shall permit such person as the Commissioner of the District or I may authorize by writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under any of the provisions of this Order.

5. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order; or

(b) makes, under any of the provisions of this Order, a declaration or return which is false in any material particular,

is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1942.
