THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2041

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

C. C. WOOLLEY,
Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Special Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1942.

2. There shall be charged a combined Postage and Air fee, in addition to late and/or registration fees, at the rates set forth in the second and third columns of the Schedule hereto, on letters, postcards, printed papers, commercial papers, samples and small packets intended for transmission by air mail to any of the countries of destination enumerated in the first column of the said Schedule, such transmission to be effected by air or surface route from the Colony to Palestine or Egypt and thence by air to the country of destination.

3. Nothing in this Order contained shall affect the operation of the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1942, which in so far as it concerns the countries of destination set out in the Schedule hereto, relates to a service partially by air and partially by surface route.

4. The Post Office (Special Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1940, is hereby revoked.
