(ii) Any person who fails to comply with any notice issued under sub-paragraph (i) of this paragraph shall be guilty of an offence against this regulation and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding five pounds for every day during which the default continues.'

 $\mathcal{L}_{(2)}$ This regulation shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 15th

day of December, 1941.

THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 13 of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:

The area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be and shall be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Tokhni, in the District of Larnaca.

SCHEDULE.

The area lying within the following boundaries, that is to say:-

The boundary commences at the most northern point of plot No. 311 of the Government Survey Plan No. LV/5 (the Greek Cemetery) on the road from Zyyi to the village of Tokhni, and proceeds northwards and north-eastwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 307, 298 and 297 of the said plan to the most northern point of plot No. 297, on a footpath; thence southeastwards and south-westwards along the said footpath through the locality "Perivolia" to the most southern point of plot No. 237 of the Government Survey Plan No. LV/13, on the main road from Nicosia to Limassol; thence southwards, crossing the said road, and south-eastwards along a footpath through the localities "Pieridhes," "Kapsaloudhia" and "Laxidhia," to the most eastern point of plot No. 371 of the Government Survey Plan LV/21; thence southwards, eastwards and southwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 372 and 375 of the said plan, plots Nos. 60, 61, 62, 63 and 64 of the Government Survey Plan No. LV/29 to the south-eastern corner of the said plot No. 64, on the road from the village of Maroni to Zyyi; thence southwards along the said road to the most southern point of plot No. 205 of the said plan; thence north-westwards and south-westwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 205 and 208 of the said plan to the most southern point of plot No. 208, on a footpath; thence north-westwards along the said footpath through the localities "Khardjes" and "Livadhia" to the south-western corner of plot No. 201 of the Government Survey Plan No. LV/21, on the road from Zyyi to the village of Tokhni; thence north-westwards and north-eastwards along the said road to the point of commencement; all which said area comprises 1,407 donums or thereabouts as shown edged in red on the plan filed in the D.L.R.S. M.P. No. 462/1940.
