THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY ACQUISITION (ALIENS) LAWS, 1936.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2078

MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

J. V. W. SHAW,

Acting Governor.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 3 of the Immovable Property Acquisition (Aliens) Laws, 1936, do hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Immovable Property Acquisition

(Aliens Restriction) Order, 1943.

- 2. From and after the date of this order, no alien shall acquire, otherwise than by inheritance, ownership of any immovable property situate in any area within the Colony, except with the consent of the Governor first obtained.
- 3. The Immovable Property Acquisition (Aliens Restriction) Order, Gazette: 1941, is hereby revoked.
