ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2079

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 59 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1942, and of every other power hereunto enabling, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Export of Goods Prohibition (Amendment) Order, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Export of Goods Prohibition Orders, 1941 to 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this order may together be cited as the Export of Goods Prohibition Orders, 1941 to 1943.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the following items:—

- " 5. Cotton and waste.
- 7. Ferrous scrap.
- 13. Non-ferrous scrap.
- 15. Silk.
- 21. Wool."

No. 131. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1943.
