**No. 157. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 AND 1942.**

**BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF FAMAGUSTA**

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 and 1942 and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta hereby make the following bye-laws:—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Famagusta Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Famagusta Municipal Bye-laws, 1940 to 1942 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Famagusta Municipal Bye-laws, 1940 to 1943.

2. Paragraph (a) of bye-law 107 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

"(a) For every bucket or receptacle of night soil for a period of *s. p.*  
one month .. .. . 10 0"

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor.
