C.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following:—

“75. Cucumbers:

**No. 177. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1939.**

**RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF  
 MOSPHILOTI UNDER SECTION 9.**

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1939, the Village Health Commission of Mosphiloti hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Mosphiloti) Rules, 1943, and shall come into operation on their publication in the *Gazette*.

2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) and (3) of this rule, the Village Health (Karavostasi) Rules, 1938, published in the *Gazette* of 4th March, 1938, shall—

(a) be deemed to be rules made by the Village Health Commission of Mosphiloti and to be incorporated herein, and

(b) Apply to the village of Mosphiloti.

(2) The rules set out in Part I of the Schedule hereto shall be substituted for the corresponding rules of the Village Health (Karavostasi) Rules, 1938.

(3) Those rules of the Village Health (Karavostasi) Rules, 1938, mentioned in Part II of the Schedule hereto, shall not apply to the village of Mosphiloti.
