No. 209. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1943.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Timber) (Amendment) Order, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Control of Timber) Order, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this order may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Timber) Orders, 1942 and 1943.

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the definition of "timber", and the substitution therefor of the following definition:—
"timber" means the several types of timber specified in the second column of the First Schedule to this order;

3. The principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of clause 4 and the substitution therefor of the following clause:—

"4.—(a) From and after the date of the publication of this order in the *Gazette* no person who has in his possession or under his control in any part of the Colony any timber in excess of the quantity specified in the third column of the First Schedule to this order shall remove, make use of, sell, dispose of or otherwise deal with, any timber of any quantity whatsoever, save under a special permit issued under the hand of the Timber Controller or a Timber Control Officer.

(b) Every special permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (a) hereof may contain such terms and conditions (including the price at which such timber may be sold or disposed of) as may be specified therein."

4. The principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of clause 5 and the substitution therefor of the following clause:—

"5. Every person who has in his possession or under his control in any part of the Colony any timber in excess of the quantity specified in the third column of the First Schedule to this order, shall—

(a) keep on his premises such books or records and enter therein such matters, as the Timber Controller may from time to time direct;

(b) not later than 7 days after the last day of each month complete and deliver to the Timber Controller at Nicosia a return in the form of, and containing the particulars set out in, the Third Schedule to this Order."

5. The principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after clause 6 of the following clause:—

"6A. The Schedules hereto may be amended by me by Notice published in the *Gazette* and upon such publication such amendment shall form part of this order for all purposes."
