THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 9) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER REGULATION 21 (1). J

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph (1) of regulation 21 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Photography Exemption (Amendment) Order, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Photography Exemption Order, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Photography Exemption Orders, 1942 and 1943.

2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the proviso and the substitution therefor of the following:—

"Provided that no person shall, save with a written permit granted by the Competent Authority,—

(a) have a camera in his possession, or take any photograph, make any sketch, plan or other representation of any place, matter or thing situated in—

(i) any area (specified as a prohibited area by an order made under the provisions of regulation 70 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942,

(ii) the area specified in the First Schedule to this Order;

(b) take any photograph, make any sketch, plan or other representation of any of the places, matters or things—

(i) specified in the Second Schedule to this Order,

(ii) situated in any area in the Colony within one mile of the coast."
