No. 233. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2088
MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1942 and 1943.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the deletion therefrom of the entry relating to "CHINA" under the heading "SERVICE PARTIALLY BY AIR AND PARTIALLY BY SURFACE ROUTE";

(b) by the insertion under the heading "SERVICE BY AIR THROUGHOUT", in their respective alphabetical order, of the following entries:—

No. 234. THE DEFENCE (AIR RAID PRECAUTION) ORDER, 1942.

NOTICE UNDER CLAUSE 2.

Notice is hereby given that His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to direct that all male persons being British subjects between the ages of eighteen and forty-five residing in the areas in the Schedule to this Notice, being areas to which the Defence (Air Raid Precaution) Order, 1942, applies and who have not already registered for the performance in such areas of part-time air raid precaution duties shall do so between the 8th day of July, 1943, and the 14th day of July, 1943, both inclusive.

SCHEDULE.

- (a) The Town of Larnaca (Municipal limits);
- (b) The Town of Limassol (Municipal limits);
- (c) The Town of Famagusta including Varosha (Municipal limits).
