THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO (No. 2) 1937.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 5.

C. C. WOOLLEY, Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Elementary Education (Holidays) (Amendment) Regulations, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Elementary Education (Holidays) Regulations, 1936 and 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Elementary Education (Holidays) Regulations, 1936 to 1943.

- 2. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:—
 - "4. The following holidays shall be observed in all Moslem Elementary Schools:-
 - (a) Each week from midday on Saturday till Sunday night.
 - (b) From the 1st July till the 14th September, inclusive: Provided that this paragraph shall not apply to any Moslem elementary school prescribed for the village of Pano Amiandos.
 - (c) From the 22nd December till the 3rd January, inclusive.
 - (d) From the 25th March till the 4th April, inclusive.
 - (e) One clear week for Ramazan Bairam.
 - (f) One clear week for Qurban Bairam.
 - (y) The feasts known as:— Mevlud (Birthday of the Prophet), the Thursday preceding Regaip (Conception of the Prophet), Miradj (Ascension of the Prophet), Berat (Dispensation of Fate)."
