THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1939.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2090

MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

Authority to the Village Health Commission of Omodhos (Limassol District) to contract a loan.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1939, do hereby order as follows:—

The Village Health Commission of Omodhos (Limassol District) (hereinafter referred to as "the Village Health Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as the "lenders") the sum of fifty pounds (£50) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

(a) The sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Village Health Commission to the lenders in three equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund

and interest).

- (b) The Village Health Commission shall, in each year and until the final repayment of the sum borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on the revenue the annual instalment payable in the year to which such estimates relate.
- (c) The sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Village Health Commission for the purpose of constructing public latrines in the village.

No. 270. THE DANGEROUS DRUGS LAWS, 1925 TO 1932.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

In exercise of the power and authority vested in him by section 13 of the Dangerous Drugs Laws, 1925 to 1932, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. The persons whose names appear in the Schedule hereto be and are hereby authorized to exercise, within the area or district appearing against the name of each such person in the third column of the said Schedule, all the powers conferred upon persons so authorized by section 13 of the said Laws.

2. The Order dated the 2nd day of February, 1942, published under Notification No. 26 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 5th February, 1942, is hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done thereunder.

No. 272. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1943.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Electrical Equipment) (Amendment) Order, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Control of Electrical Equipment) Orders, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Electrical Equipment) Orders, 1942 to 1943.

2. Clause 4 of the principal Order is hereby deleted and the following clause

- substituted therefor:—
 "4.—(1) From and after the 5th day of August, 1943, no person shall remove, make use of, sell or dispose of any of the articles described in the First Schedule hereto save under a permit issued under the hand of the Electrical and Mechanical Engineer.
 - (2) Every permit issued under the provisions of sub-clause (1) of this clause may contain such terms and conditions (including the price at which such articles are to be sold or disposed of) as may be specified therein.

(3) Nothing in this clause shall apply to any of the articles described in the First Schedule hereto if such articles-

(a) are held or used by any person for his reasonable domestic requirements; (b) are already incorporated in any structure or manufactured article".
