No. 283. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2091

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Airgraph Rate of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Airgraph Rate of Postage) Order, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Airgraph Rate of Postage) Orders, 1942 and 1943. *Gazette: Supplement No. 3: 29.10.1942*

2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after the words "United Kingdom", which appear in the first line thereof, of the words "Australia, New Zealand, Fiji Islands, Tonga and New Hebrides,".

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of September, 1943.
