~~I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 89 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, do hereby make the following order:—~~

~~1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Licensing of Certain Goods) (Fees) Order, 1943.~~

~~2. From and after the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* there shall be charged and paid in respect of the issue or renewal of any licence issued or renewed under the provisions of the Defence (Licensing of Certain Goods) Order, 1943, a fee not exceeding three pounds, as the Commissioner of the District may determine.~~

THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO (No. 2) 1937.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 74 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 74 (1) of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to direct and it is hereby directed that the tax mentioned in section 65 of the said Laws payable by the Maronite tax-payers of the villages mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be increased by the rate per thousand mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule hereto to provide the amount required for the payment of loans or annual maintenance of the Maronite schools of the said villages respectively.
