#### No. 296. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1943.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of New Shoes and Boots) Order, 1943.

2. In this Order—

“ shoes ” means men’s, women’s and children’s shoes made of leather or canvas and leather and includes sandals and slippers (pantoufles);

“ boots ” means men’s, women’s and children’s boots made of leather or canvas and leather and includes “ podhines ” either “ franjidhes ” or “ tsan-garissimes ”.

3. Within seven days from the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every person who has in his possession or under his control any new shoes or boots

exceeding three pairs shall complete and deliver to me, at Nicosia, a return in the form of, and containing the particulars set out in, the First Schedule hereto, in respect of the shoes and boots in his possession or under his control :

Provided that the provisions of this clause shall not apply to any person who, on or before the 6th day of August, 1943, has completed and delivered a return in respect of shoes and boots in his possession or under his control under the provisions of the Defence (Control of Stocks of New Shoes and Boots) Order, 1943.

4. Not later than 6 days after the last day of every month, commencing from the month of August, 1943, every person who has in his possession or under his control any new shoes or boots in excess of the quantity stated in clause 3 of this Order, shall complete and deliver to me, at Nicosia, a return of the shoes and boots in his possession or under his control, in the form set forth in the Second Schedule hereto.

5. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under any of the provisions of this Order.

6. Any person who—

- (a) contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Order ;
- (b) makes any return required to be made under the provisions of this Order which is false in any material particular ;
- (c) knowingly misleads or otherwise interferes with or impedes any person exercising any powers or performing any duties under the provisions of this Order ;

is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943.

7. The Defence (Control of Stocks of New Shoes and Boots) Order, 1943, is hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.
