No. 298. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1943.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, I hereby order as follows:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Boots and Shoes) Order, 1943.
- 2.-(1) From and after the 19th day of August, 1943, no person shall manufacture, make or repair or shall sell or expose for sale, any boots, shoes or any other footwear of any kind save under a permit issued under my hand or under the hand of any person authorized by me in writing in that behalf.
- (2) Every permit issued under the provisions of sub-clause (1) of this clause may contain such terms and conditions (including the price at which boots, shoes or other footwear may be sold) as may be specified therein.
- 3. Any person desiring to obtain a permit under this Order shall apply to me at Nicosia, giving his full name, the address of his place of business and the number of persons employed in connection with such business.
- 4. The provisions of this Order shall be in addition to, and not in derogation of, the provisions of the Defence (Licensing of Dealers of Certain Goods) Orders, 1942 to 1943:

Provided that if any term or condition imposed under this Order is inconsistent with any term or condition imposed under the said Orders, the term or condition imposed under this Order shall prevail.

5. Any person who-

- (a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, the provisions of this Order; 24,12.1942
- (b) makes any false statement in any application for a permit under this Order; (c) fails to comply with any term or condition contained in any permit issued

under this Order; is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943.

6. The Defence (Control of Boots and Shoes) Order, 1942, is hereby revoked Gazette: without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder:

Provided that any permit issued by the Leather Control Board under the Order No. 3: hereby revoked and subsisting on the date of the publication of this Order in the 31.12.1942 Gazette shall be deemed to be a permit issued under and for the purposes of this Order.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as a Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, I hereby order as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Livestock (Amendment) Order, 1943, Gazette: and shall be read as one with the Control of Livestock Order, 1943, (hereinafter Supplement referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may No. 3: together be cited as the Control of Livestock Orders, 1943.

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of clause 6

and the substitution therefor of the following clause:—

"6. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order, no permit shall be required for the buying and selling or otherwise disposing of livestock where both the buyer and seller are resident in the same village: Provided that notice of the transfer of ownership of such livestock shall be given to the Mukhtar of the village within 24 hours and that such livestock shall not be moved out of the village area until such notice shall have been given."
