THE JUVENILE OFFENDERS LAW, 1935.

DECLARATION OF REFORMATORY UNDER SECTION 2.

C. C. WOOLLEY, Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Juvenile Offenders Law, 1935, do hereby declare the premises and lands set out in the Schedule hereto to be a Reformatory for the purposes of the said Law.

THE JUVENILE OFFENDERS LAW, 1935.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 16.

C. C. WOOLLEY, Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Juvenile Offenders Law, 1935, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Juvenile Offenders (Reformatory)

Regulations, 1943.

2. In these regulations—
"Reformatory" means any place declared by the Governor to be a reformatory for the purposes of the Juvenile Offenders Law, 1935.
