DELEGATION OF POWERS UNDER PARAGRAPH (5) OF REGULATION 66.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph (5) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, do hereby depute the persons for the time being holding the offices designated in the second column of the Schedule hereto to exercise and perform on my behalf the powers mentioned in the first column of the said Schedule which I am empowered to exercise and perform under the provisions of paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943.

2. The Orders published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazettes* of the 28th May, 1942, and the 5th November, 1942, under Notifications Nos. 189 and 440, respectively, are hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done thereunder.
