THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940 TO 1942.

NOTICE NO. 119 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion from Part 2 of the limitation thereto and the substitution therefor of the following :—

" Limitation :

The maximum price for sales from Government stocks of barley intended for human consumption is $2\frac{3}{4}$ piastres per oke."

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the addition to Part 8 of the following :—

C.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 13 and the substitution therefor of the following Part :—

" PART 15.—COWPEAS (LOUVIA).

In this Part of the Schedule-

the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of cowpeas in quantities in excess of 40 okes at any one time or at any single transaction."

D.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following Part :— '' PART 17.—LOCAL CHEESE.

In this part of the Schedule the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of *Kaskavalli* in quantities in excess of 5 okes at any one time or at any single transaction.

Modification : Provided that where kaskavalli is sold in any town or village other than Nicosia there may be added to the maximum retail price one plastre per oke."
