SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

A PROCLAMATION.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the boundaries of the villages of Ayii Omoloyitadhes and Strovolos in the District of Nicosia :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Section 17 of the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby order and proclaim that from and after the 31st day of October, 1943 the area described in the Schedule hereto, heretofore reckoned within the boundaries of the village of Ayii Omoloyitadhes shall form part of the lands of the village of Strovolos and that the boundaries of the said villages of Ayii Omoloyitadhes and Strovolos shall be altered accordingly.

SCHEDULE.

The boundary of the area commences at the north-eastern corner of the "Evghenia Theodotou" Orphanage, (plot No. 233, Block "B", Ayii Omoloyitadhes), on the main road from Nicosia to Larnaca and proceeds westwards along the southern side of the road to the village of Ayii Omoloyitadhes, *via* Ayia Paraskevi Church to the most northern point of plot No. 60, block "B", Ayii Omoloyitadhes, on the main road from the village of Palouriotissa to the village of Strovolos; thence south-westwards along the eastern side of the said main road to the most northern point of plot No. 48, Block "J", Strovolos village, which is on the boundary of the village of Ayii Omoloyitadhes; thence south-eastwards and northwards along the said village boundary to the point of commencement all which said area comprises Blocks "B" (part) and "D" (whole), Ayii Omoloyitadhes.
