A PROCLAMATION.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 17 of the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby order and proclaim that from and after the 1st day of November, 1943 :—

1. The boundary of the Town of Nicosia shall be as set forth in Schedule A hereof.
2. The Town of Nicosia comprised within the boundary aforesaid shall be divided into the quarters set forth in Schedule B hereof.
3. The Order made by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government dated the 3rd August, 1923, and published in the *Gazette* of the 4th August, 1923, under Notification No. 397, as amended by the Order made by His Excellency the High Commissioner dated the 29th February, 1924 and published in the *Gazette* of the 29th February, 1924, under Notification No. 112, and the Proclamation made by His Excellency the Governor dated the 22nd September, 1938, and published under Notification No. 177 in Supplement No. 3 to *Gazette* No. 2676 of the 23rd September, 1938, as amended by subsequent Proclamations, shall be revoked.

SCHEDULE A.

Boundary of the Town of Nicosia.

The boundary commences on the south-western side of the main road from Nicosia to Kyrenia where it is crossed by the road from the tannery near the Golf Course to the village of Trakhonas, and proceeds north-eastwards along the western side of the latter road to a point due west of the north-western corner of plot No. 15, Block A, Trakhonas; thence eastwards along the northern boundary of this plot to its north-eastern corner on the main road from the village of Trakhonas to Nicosia; thence south eastwards for a distance of 100 feet approximately along the said road to the north-western corner of plot No. 16, Block A, Trakhonas; thence eastwards and southwards along the northern and eastern boundaries of the said plot and the northern boundary of plot No. 17 of the said Block to the north-eastern corner of the said plot No. 17; thence southwards, eastwards and southwards following the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 17, 19, 21, 27, 40, 52, 53 and 54 of Block A, Trakhonas, to the most eastern point of the said plot No. 54; thence eastwards in a straight line for a distance of 130 feet approximately to the point on the western boundary of plot No. 13, Block B, Omorphita, 120 feet south of the north-western corner of this plot; thence southwards along the boundaries of but excluding plots Nos. 13, 14, 16 and 17 of Block B, Omorphita, to the south-eastern corner of the said plot No. 17 on a road which forms the northern boundary of the Nicosia Railway Station; thence eastwards along the northern side of the said road to the eastern side of the main road from the village of Omorphita to Nicosia; thence south-westwards along the eastern side of the said main road to the boundary of the village of Omorphita; thence eastwards along the southern side of the said railway to the most northern point of plot No. 131, Block B, Omorphita, on the main road from the village of Omorphita to the village of Palouriotissa; thence south-eastwards along the eastern side of the said main road to the cross-roads at the most northern point of plot No. 40, Block A, Palouriotissa; thence south-westwards along the eastern side of the road from the village of Beuyuk Kaimakli to the Famagusta Gate of Nicosia to the junction of roads at the south-western corner of plot No. 137, Block A, Palouriotissa; thence southwards along the eastern side of the road leading to the main road from Nicosia to Kythrea to the south-western corner of plot No. 62 of the said Block; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the most northern point of the Turkish Cemetery (plot No. 4, Block 23, Taht-el-Kale Quarter); thence south-westwards along the eastern side of the said Turkish Cemetery to the main road from Famagusta Gate of Nicosia to Larnaca; thence south-eastwards along the northern side of the said main road to the cross-roads at the most northern point of plot No. 24, Block D, Palouriotissa; thence southwards along the eastern side of the road to the Isolation Hospital to the north-western corner of plot No. 95, Block D, Palouriotissa; thence westwards along the southern side of the road leading to the main road from the Ayios Antonios School to Larnaca; thence south-eastwards along the eastern side of the said main road to the cross-roads at the north-eastern corner of the Mental Hospital; thence

westwards along the southern side of the road bounding the said hospital to the main road from the old Nicosia Greek Cemetery to Larnaca; thence south-eastwards along the eastern side of the said main road to the north-eastern corner of the Evghenia Theodotou Orphanage (plot No. 233, Block B, Ayii Omoloyitadhes); thence westwards along the southern boundary of the road from Ayia Paraskovi to the village of Ayii Omoloyitadhes to the most northern point of plot No. 60, Block B, Ayii Omoloyitadhes, on the main road from the village of Palouriotissa to the village of Strovolos; thence south-westwards along the eastern side of the said main road to the Strovolos bridge, on the boundary of the village of Strovolos; thence northwards along the said village boundary and along the boundary of the village of Engomi (including the roads where the village boundaries follow roads) to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 83, Block B, Engomi, on a track; thence westwards along the southern side of the said track to the main road from the Nicosia-Troödos road bridge to the village of Engomi; thence south-westwards along the western side of the said main road to the most southern point of plot No. 186, Block C, Engomi, on a track; thence westwards along the southern side of the said track, (crossing a road from the Nicosia-Troödos road to Kykko Monastery) to the south-western corner of plot No. 207, Block C, Engomi; thence northwards along the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 207, 205, 204, 201, 200 and 194 of the said Block to the north-western corner of the said plot No. 194 on the Nicosia-Troödos main road; thence westwards along the said main road in a straight line to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 71, Block Q, Ayios Dhometios, at a junction of roads; thence northwards along the western side of the road leading to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 69 of the said Block on the Nicosia-Myrto main road; thence westwards along the said main road to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 80, Block N, Ayios Dhometios, at a junction of roads; thence northwards along the western side of the road leading to the most northern point of plot No. 89 of the said Block at a junction of roads; thence north-eastwards along the northern side of the road leading to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 126 of the said Block at a junction of roads; thence northwards along the western side of the road leading to the junction of roads at the north-eastern corner of plot No. 133, Block N, Ayios Dhometios; thence north-westwards along the southern side of the road leading to the cross-roads at the south-eastern corner of plot No. 164, Block B, Ayios Dhometios; thence northwards along the western side of a road to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 53, Block H, Ayios Dhometios, at a cross-roads; thence eastwards along the northern side of a road to the cross-roads at the south-eastern corner of plot No. 51 of the said Block; thence northwards and north-eastwards along the western and northern side of a road to the most southern point of plot No. 3, Block K, Ayios Dhometios; thence northwards along the western boundary of the said plot to the road forming the southern boundary of the Nicosia Golf Course; thence eastwards along the northern side of the said road to the right bank of the River Pedicos; thence northwards along the said bank to the Cyprus Government Railway Bridge; thence eastwards along the southern side of the said Railway to the western side of the road from the tannery near the Golf Course to the village of Trakhonas; thence north-eastwards along the western side of the said road to the point of commencement, all which said boundary is hatched in black on the Government Survey plan Serial No. 1256.

SCHEDULE B.

Quarters of the Town of Nicosia.

1. The quarters of Abdi Chavish, Ak-Kavik, Chrysaliniotissa, Haydar Pasha, Ayios Ioannis, Ayios Kassianos, Korkoud Effendi and Iblik Bazaar, Karamanzade, Ayios Loukas, Mahmoud Pasha, Nebet Khane, Omerie, Phaneromeni, Trypiotis, Ayios Savas, Ayia Sophia, and Tabak Khane, comprising respectively the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within the quarters aforesaid.

2. The Ibrahim Pasha quarter comprising—

(a) the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within the quarter aforesaid; and

(b) the following areas hitherto forming part of the village areas of Trakhonas and Omorphita respectively, that is to say,—

(i) From the village of Trakhonas, the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within Block "A" Trakhonas, all which said properties are shown hatched blue and numbered 1 on the Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.

- (ii) From the village of Omorphita, an area bounded as follows:—
The boundary commences at the most eastern point of plot No. 227, Block "A" Trakhonas, on the boundary of the village of Omorphita on the northern side of the road which forms the northern boundary of the Nicosia Railway Station, (Plan No. XXI.38.5.IV), and proceeds eastwards along the northern side of the said road to the eastern side of the main road from Nicosia to the village of Omorphita; thence south-westwards along the eastern side of the said main road to the boundary of the village of Omorphita; thence westwards along the boundary of the village of Omorphita to the level crossing at which the main-road from Nicosia to Trakhonas crosses the Cyprus Government Railway; thence northwards and eastwards along the said village boundary to the point of commencement, all of which said area is shown hatched blue and numbered 2 on the Government Survey plan Serial No. 1256.
3. The Yoni Jami Quarter comprising—
- (a) the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within the quarter aforesaid; and
- (b) the following areas hitherto forming part of the village areas of Omorphita, Beuyuk Kaimakli and Palouriotissa, that is to say—
- (i) From the village of Omorphita an area bounded as follows:—
The boundary commences at the north-western corner of plot No. 123 of Block "B", Omorphita (Government Survey plan No. XXI.38.6.IV) on the southern boundary of the Cyprus Government Railway strip, and proceeds along the southern side of the said railway strip to the most northern point of plot No. 131 of Block "B", Omorphita, on a road; thence south-eastwards to the main road from the Nicosia Railway Station to Beuyuk Kaimakli; thence south-westwards along the said main road to the south-western corner of plot No. 123, Block "B", Omorphita; thence north-westwards along the western point of the said plot to the point of commencement, all which said area is shown hatched violet and numbered 3 on Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.
- (ii) From the village of Beuyuk Kaimakli, the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within Block "O", Beuyuk Kaimakli, all of which said properties are shown hatched violet and numbered 4 on the Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.
- (iii) From the village of Palouriotissa, the following properties:—Plots Nos. 1 and 2, Block "A" Palouriotissa, (Government Survey plan No. XXI.47.1.1), all of which said plots are shown hatched violet and numbered 5 on the Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.
4. The Taht-el-Kale Quarter, comprising—
- (a) the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within the quarter aforesaid; and
- (b) the following areas, hitherto forming part of the village area of Palouriotissa, that is to say plot No. 3, (Government Survey plan No. XXI.47.1.III), plots Nos. 57, 59, 60, 61, 58, 57, and 56 (Government Survey plan No. XXI.47.4.1), all of Block "A" Palouriotissa, all which said areas are shown hatched red and numbered 6 on Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.
5. The Ayios Antonios Quarter comprising:—
- (a) the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within the quarter aforesaid; and
- (b) the following area hitherto forming part of the village area of Palouriotissa, that is to say, the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within Block "C" Palouriotissa, all which said properties are shown hatched blue and numbered 7 on Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.
6. The Top-Khane Quarter comprising—
- (a) the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within the quarter aforesaid; and

(b) the following areas hitherto forming part of the village areas of Ayii Omoloyitadhes, Engomi and Ayios Dhometios, that is to say—

- (i) From the village of Ayii Omoloyitadhes, plots Nos. 379, 381 and 382, Block "A", Ayii Omoloyitadhes, all which said plots are shown hatched brown and numbered 8 on the Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.
- (ii) From the village of Engomi, the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the property within Block "C" Engomi, all which said properties are shown hatched brown and numbered 9 on the Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.
- (iii) From the village of Ayios Dhometios, the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within Block "P", "L" & "M", Ayios Dhometios, all which said properties are shown hatched brown and numbered 10 on the Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.

7. The Arab Ahmed Quarter comprising—

- (a) the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within the quarter aforesaid ; and
- (b) the following areas hitherto forming part of the village areas of Ayios Dhometios and Orta Kouy, that is to say :—
 - (i) From the village of Ayios Dhometios, the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within block "K" Ayios Dhometios, all which said properties are shown hatched yellow and numbered 11 on the Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.
 - (ii) From the village of Orta Kouy, the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within Block "A" Orta Kouy, all which said properties are shown hatched yellow and numbered 12 on the Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.

8. The Ayii Omoloyitadhes Quarter comprising—

- (i) All properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within Block "A" of the village of Ayii Omoloyitadhes with the exception of plots Nos. 379, 381 and 382, all which said properties are shown hatched green and numbered 15 on the Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.
- (ii) The area bounded as follows :—The boundary commences at the north-western corner of plot No. 1, Block "B", Ayii Omoloyitadhes on the boundary of the village of Ayii Omoloyitadhes (plan No. XXI.54.2.III) and proceeds eastwards along the said village boundary to the junction of roads at the south-eastern corner of plot No. 256, Block "B" Ayii Omoloyitadhes, on the main road from the village of Palouriotissa to the village of Strovolos ; thence south-westwards along the eastern side of the said main road to the junction of roads at the southern corner of plot No. 138, Block "B" Ayii Omoloyitadhes ; thence north-westwards along the other road to the main road from Government House to the Government Offices ; thence northwards along the said main road to the point of commencement, all which said area is shown hatched green and numbered 14 on the Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.
- (iii) All properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within Block "C" of the village of Ayii Omoloyitadhes, all which said properties are shown hatched green and numbered 13 on the Government Survey plan, Serial No. 1256.
