No. 366. THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY TAX LAWS, 1932 TO 1942.

### ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2100 MADE UNDER SECTION 5A.

C. C. WOOLLEY,

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5A of the Immovable Property Tax Laws, 1932 to 1942, do hereby order as follows:— 1. This Order may be cited as the Immovable Property Tax (Increase) Order,

2. The rate of the immovable property tax in respect of immovable property owned by any person within the limits of any town or quarter of a town shall, for the year 1944, be increased by four per thousand on the capital value of such property as assessed in accordance with the provisions of the above mentioned Laws.

3. The rate of the immovable property tax in respect of immovable property owned by any person within the limits of any village or quarter of a village shall, for the year 1944, be increased by two and a half per thousand on the capital value of such property as assessed in accordance with the provisions of the above mentioned

THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage)
Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1942 and 1943, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1942 to (No. 2) 1943.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to "Belgian Congo" and "Switzerland" under the hading "SERVICE PARTIALLY BY AIR AND PARTIALLY BY SURFACE ROUTE"; and by the insertion, under that heading, in its proper alphabetical order, of the following entry: following entry:

#### No. 368. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1943,

#### ELECTION OF MAYOR AND DEPUTY MAYOR.

It is hereby notified for general information that Mr. Ploutis Loizou Servas and Dr. Vasos Haritonos Papadopoulos have been elected Mayor and Deputy Mayor, respectively, of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol, in accordance with the provisions of section 55 of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1943.

#### No. 369. The Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, 1938.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, 1938, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Prodhromos ("Hardji-Mazourka" Water), in the District of Limassol, are published in the Gazette. (M.P. 1230/23.)

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF PRODHROMOS ("HARDJI-MAZOURKA" WATER). Rules.

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Prodhromos ("Hardji-Mazourka" Water) Rules, 1943.

  - 2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires—
    "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the District of Limassol;
  - "Committee" means the Committee of the Irrigation Division;
    "Irrigation Division" means the Irrigation Division of Prodhromos ("Hardji-Mazourka" Water);
    "Law" means the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, 1938;

  - "list" means the list of the names and residence of the proprietors and of the lands and extent thereof which are to be benefited or are capable of being benefited by the works prepared under the provisions of section 15 of the Law as finally settled under the provisions of section 16 of the Law; "works" means the irrigation works of the Irrigation Division.
- 3. The Committee shall hold office for a period of three years beginning on the 9th November, 1941. Thereafter the election of the Committee shall take place every third year in the first week of the month of November and it shall hold office for a period of three years from the 9th November next following its election.
- 4.—(1) The Committee shall appoint a treasurer who shall collect the rates and charges assessed upon the proprietors mentioned in the list.
- (2) The treasurer shall, on the 1st November in every year, prepare a statement of all rates or charges still due and unpaid on that date and shall forward such statement to the Commissioner.
- (3) The treasurer shall be unpaid: Provided that he shall be paid such of his out of pocket expenses as may be sanctioned by the Committee.
- (4) The treasurer shall be appointed for such period as the Committee may fix but in no case extending over the term of office of the Committee appointing such
