

No. 38. THE ADVOCATES LAWS, 1933 TO 1940.

AUTHORIZATION UNDER SECTION 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Advocates Laws, 1933 to 1940, I hereby authorize Mr. Haralambos A. Theodossiades, an officer of the Medical Department, to appear, plead and act in any proceeding taken or instituted under section 19 and sections 25 to 34 (both inclusive) of the Mental Patients Law, 1931, to which the Crown, the Government of Cyprus or any officer of the Government in his official capacity is a party.

2. The authorization published under Notification No. 244 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th of June, 1940, is hereby cancelled.

X THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 9) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Typewriters Control) Order, 1943.

2. Within four days of the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* any person who has in his possession or under his control any typewriter shall complete and deliver to me a return in the form and containing the particulars set forth in the Schedule hereto.

3.—(a) From and after the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, no person shall sell, hire, or dispose of, any typewriter to any person except under a special permit issued under my hand.

(b) Any special permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (a) hereof may contain such terms and conditions (including the price at which any typewriter may be sold or purchased) as may be specified therein.

4. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under any of the provisions of this Order.

5. Any person who—

- (a) contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Order ;
- (b) makes any return required to be made under the provisions of this Order which is false in any material particular ;
- (c) fails to comply with any condition in any special permit issued under this Order ;

(d) knowingly misleads or otherwise interferes with or impedes any person exercising any powers or performing any duties under the provisions of this Order ;
is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942.

6. Nothing in this order shall apply to any typewriter which is the property of the Government or of His Majesty's Forces.

THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1939.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF PYLA
UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1939, the Village Health Commission of Pyla hereby make the following rules :—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Pyla) Rules, 1942, and shall come into operation on their publication in the *Gazette*.

2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) and (3) of this rule, the Village Health (Karavostasi) Rules, 1938, published in the *Gazette* of the 4th March, 1938, shall—

- (a) be deemed to be rules made by the Village Health Commission of Pyla and to be incorporated herein, and
- (b) apply to the village of Pyla.

(2) The rules set out in Part I of the Schedule hereto shall be substituted for the corresponding rules of the Village Health (Karavostasi) Rules, 1938.
