

No. 412. THE PORT REGULATION LAWS, 1879 TO 1935.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Port Regulation Laws, 1879 to 1935, and of every other power hereunto enabling, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Pilotage (Amendment) Regulations, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Pilotage Regulations, 1935 and 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Pilotage Regulations, 1935 to 1943.

2. Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is hereby repealed and the following regulation substituted therefor:—

"5. The fees to be paid by vessels in respect of pilotage into or out of any port shall be as follows:—

| (a) For vessels not exceeding 1,500 tons register | 2 | 0 | 0 |
| (b) For vessels exceeding 1,500 tons register | 3 | 0 | 0 |

Provided that the Comptroller may, with the approval of the Governor, exempt any vessels from the payment of any such fees".

THE CYPRUS CURRENCY NOTES ORDER AND LAW, 1928 AND 1935, /

THE DEFENCE (AMENDMENT OF THE CYPRUS CURRENCY NOTES
ORDER AND LAW, 1928 AND 1935) REGULATIONS, 1942.

RULES MADE UNDER ARTICLE XV.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article XV of the Cyprus Currency Notes Order and Law, 1928 and 1935, as amended by the Defence (Amendment of the Cyprus Currency Notes Order and Law, 1928 and 1935) Regulations, 1942, with the approval of the Secretary of State, do hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Cyprus Currency Notes (Amendment No. 3) Rules, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Currency Notes Rules, 1942 to (No. 2) 1943, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Cyprus Currency Notes Rules, 1942 to (No. 3) 1943.

2. Rule 14 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after the words "Destroyed Notes, and" (line 3) of the words "in the case of notes of a denomination of 10s. or over".

3. Rule 16 of the principal Rules is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the insertion therein immediately after the words "currency notes" (line 2) of the words "of a denomination of 10s. or over";
- (b) by the insertion therein immediately after the word "any" (line 4) of the word "such".

4. Rule 17 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following proviso:—

"Provided that in the case of notes of a denomination of less than 10s. each prefix number of a series shall be sub-divided into five or ten groups as the Commissioner of Currency may think fit, and records as provided in this rule shall be kept separately in respect of each such group".

5. Paragraph (1) of rule 21 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following proviso:—

"Provided that no numbers of notes of a denomination of less than 10s. need be recorded."
