

No. 424. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1943.**ORDER MADE BY THE CONTROLLER OF TRANSPORT AND MARKETING UNDER REGULATION 61.**

In exercise of the powers vested in the Controller of Supplies under paragraph (1) of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, duly deputed to me under paragraph (6) of the said regulation and of every other power hereunto enabling, I do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Pedal Bicycles (Control of Storage and Sale of Spare Parts) (Revocation) Order, 1943.

2. From and after the 18th day of November, 1943, the Motor Vehicles and Pedal Bicycles (Control of Storage and Sale of Spare Parts) Order, 1941, shall be revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

No. 425. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1943.**ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Cattle and Meat (Retail Prices) Order, 1943.

2. In this Order—

“kid” means the meat of any goat having no permanent incisor teeth but does not include the meat of unweaned kid;

“lamb” means the meat of any sheep having no permanent incisor teeth but does not include the meat of unweaned sheep;

“meat” means the flesh or carcass, whether fresh, chilled or frozen, of any bull, cow, ox, heifer, calf, sheep, goat or swine or the young of any such animal or any portion thereof;

“purchase” includes—

(a) any offer to purchase;

(b) any attempt to purchase;

(c) any arrangement to purchase made either directly or indirectly;

“retail” means sale or purchase of meat in quantities less than a whole carcass as defined in the Control of Cattle and Meat (Liveweight and Carcass Weight Prices) Orders, 1942 to (No. 2) 1943;

“sell” includes—

(a) any offer to sell;

(b) any attempt to sell;

(c) any arrangement to sell made either directly or indirectly.

3. Subject to such definitions, conditions, exceptions, limitations and modifications, if any, as may be set out in the Schedule hereto, no person shall sell or purchase any meat of the kind mentioned in such Schedule, by retail, at a price in excess of the price relating to such meat specified in such Schedule :

Provided that whenever the price for the whole quantity of such meat involves the payment of a fraction of ten paras, there may be charged and paid therefor a sum of ten paras.

4. The Schedule hereto may be amended by me by notice published in the *Gazette* and upon such publication such amendment shall form part of this Order for all purposes.

5. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf to enter upon his premises or property for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with.

6. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order, or

(b) knowingly misleads or otherwise interferes with or impedes any person exercising any powers or performing any duties under the provisions of this Order,

is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulations 61 and 94 of the Defence Regulations 1940 to (No. 1) 1943.

7. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 15th day of November, 1943.
