RULES MADE UNDER ARTICLE XV.

I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by Article XV of the Cyprus Currency Notes Order and Law, 1928 and 1935, as amended by the Defence (Amendment of the Cyprus Currency Notes Order and Law, 1928 and 1935) Regulations, 1942, with the approval of the Secretary of State, do hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Cyprus Currency Notes (Amendment) Rules, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Currency Notes Rules, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Cyprus Currency Notes Rules, 1942 and 1943. 2. The principal Rules are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after rule 26 of the following rule:— Insertion of
new rule 26a
in the
principal
Rules.

"26a. In addition to the currency notes which may be issued under rule 26 of these rules the currency notes of the denomination of one shilling referred to therein may be over-printed as follows:—

(a) on the face—

(i) the denomination in figures of "1/-" shall be ruled out and the figure "3" inserted alongside;

(ii) the figure "3" shall be inserted in the bottom left and right hand corners;

(iii) the denomination in words of "one shilling" in English, Greek and Turkish shall be ruled out and the words "three piastres" substituted therefor in English, Greek and Turkish;

(b) on the reverse the figure "3" shall be inserted in each of the four corners and in the centre;

and issued as currency notes of the denomination of three piastres."
