No. 442. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1943.

Order made by a Competent Authority under Regulation 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks and Control of Raisins) (Amendment) Order, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Returns of Stocks and Control of Raisins) Order, 1943, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks and Control of Raisins) Orders, 1943.

- 2. The principal Order is hereby amended as follows :--(a) by the deletion of the words "one ton" in the third lines, respectively, of sub-clause (1) and sub-clause (2) of clause 3 and sub-clause (1) of clause 5, and the substitution therefor, in each case, of the words "five tons";
- (b) by the deletion therefrom of clause 4 and the substitution therefor of the

mencing from the month of November, 1943, every person who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of raisins in excess of five tons shall complete and deliver to me a return in the form set forth in the Second Schedule hereto in respect of the raisins in his possession or under his control."
