✓ THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR.

I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1942, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Defence (Control of Silver Coinage) (Amendment) Regulations, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Control of Silver Coinage) Regulations, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Coinage) Regulations, 1942 and 1943.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the word "silver" wherever it occurs.

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 25th day of February, 1943.

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO (No. 2) 1942.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2073

MADE UNDER SECTION 116 (a) (i).

Authority to the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Lefka to contract a loan.

Acting Governor.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 116 (a) (i) of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to (No. 2) 1942, do hereby order as follows:—

(a) that the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Councillors and Townsmen of the Municipal Corporation of Lefka (hereinafter referred to as "the Municipal Corporation") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Government of Cyprus the sum of $\pounds 5,000$ at a rate of interest not exceeding 2% per annum subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say —

- (i) that the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Municipal Corporation to the Government of Cyprus in fifteen equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest), and the commencement of the repayment shall be postponed until the end of the present war or until the Municipal Corporation regains solvency, whichever may be the earlier,
- (ii) that the Municipal Corporation shall, subject to the provisions regarding repayment in sub-paragraph (i), in each year and until final repayment of the sum borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on its revenues the annual sum payable as aforesaid in the year to which such estimates relate,

(iii) that the sum borrowed shall be utilized to meet the deficit in the general account and for providing funds for running the Municipal Corporation during the present emergency;

(b) that for the purpose of securing the repayment of the above named sum the Municipal Corporation shall, subject to any prior encumbrances thereon, mortgage to the Government of Cyprus all the rates, fees and duties now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Municipal Corporation.

THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 9) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942, I hereby order as follows :-

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Prices in Establishments) Control (Amendment) Order, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Prices in Establishments) Control Order, 1942, (hereinafter Gazette: referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Supplement Order may together be cited as the Defence (Prices in Establishments) No. 3: Control Orders, 1942 and 1943.

2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the definition of the word "Board" and the substitution therefor of the following definition :-

"'Board' means a board established under the provisions of clause 3A of this Order; provided that in default of establishment in any district of any such board it shall mean the District Price Fixing Board, appointed as Competent Authority under regulation 3 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942, as constituted from time to time, exercising power and authority within such district : ".

3. The principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after clause 3 of the following clause :-

"3A. There may be established in each district a board composed of a chairman and of such other persons, not exceeding four, as members, as the Commissioner of the District may appoint for the purposes of this Order."
