No. 451. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1943.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF FAMAGUSTA.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1943 and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta hereby make the following bye-laws:-

- 1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Famagusta Municipal (Amendment No. 2) Gazettes: Bye-laws, 1943 and shall be read as one with the Famagusta Municipal Bye-laws, 1940 to 1943 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Famagusta Municipal Bye-laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1943.
- 2. Bye-law 13 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby repealed and the following bye-law substituted therefor :-
 - "13. The following premises, that is to say,-
 - (a) the shops Nos. 51 to 59 situated in the Municipal Market No. 1, and

- (b) the shops Nos. 2 and 3 situated in the Municipal Market No. 2, are hereby established as fish markets for fresh fish, and may be let on hire by the Council on such terms as it may think fit."
- 3. Bye-law 177 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following paragraphs:—
 - "(4) There are hereby provided for the storage of petroleum class B and petroleum class C the stores known as 'Martinengo Bastion (Top Khane)' which are included in plot No. I, Block 'A', Famagusta Old Town.
 - (5) There are hereby provided for the storage of petroleum class B (in barrels) and petroleum class C (in barrels) the surrounded yard, situated in front of Martinengo Bastion, known as 'Martinengo Square' in plot No. 1, Famagusta Old Town."

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor. (M.P. 615/12/5.)
