The Quarantine Law, 1932.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, or otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to declare and it is hereby declared that the local areas in the first column of the Schedule hereto are infected local areas and that all passengers and goods therefrom shall, as from the date hereof, be subject to the measures prescribed by the Quarantine Regulations, 1932 to 1936, with respect to the dangerous infectious diseases in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

The Notification No. 512, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 17th December, 1942, is hereby cancelled.

No. 8. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 9) 1942.
