**THE CYPRUS VOLUNTEER FORCE LAWS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1941, AS AMENDED BY THE AMENDMENT OF THE CYPRUS VOLUNTEER FORCE LAWS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1941, (DEFENCE) REGULATIONS, 1942.**

PROCLAMATION MADE UNDER SECTION 11A.

Whereas by section 11A of the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, as amended by the Amendment of the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, (Defence) Regulations, 1942, it is enacted that the Governor may, by Proclamation, call out and mobilize the Force or any part thereof for actual service whenever it appears advisable to do so:

And whereas it appears to me advisable to call out and mobilize a certain officer:

Now, therefore, I, John Valentine Wistar Shaw, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Acting Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 11A of the said Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, as amended by the Amendment of the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, (Defence) Regulations, 1942, do hereby, by this Proclamation, call out and mobilize Second Lieutenant Robert Wight as from the 1st day of January, 1943.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the Colony at Nicosia, this 9th day of March, 1943.

**No. 67. THE AGRICULTURAL FERTILIZERS LAW, 1922.**

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 11.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 11 of the Agricultural Fertilizers Law, 1922, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Fertilizers (Amendment) Regulations, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Fertilizers Regulations, 1922 to 1935, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Agricultural Fertilizers Regulations, 1922 to 1943.

2. Regulation 7 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figures and words "4½p. for each sack or part thereof" and the substitution therefor of the words "at the rate of five shillings for each ton".

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 27th day of November, 1942.
