# THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO (No. 2) 1942.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF MORPHOU.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to (No. 2) 1942, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Morphou hereby make the following bye-laws:—

- 1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Morphou Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Morphou Municipal Bye-laws, 1941 to 1942 (hereinafter called "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Morphou Municipal Bye-laws, 1941 to 1943.
- 2. Bye-law 137 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "twenty-two piastres for every hour" and the substitution therefor of the words "twenty-eight piastres for every hour".

The above bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Acting Governor.
