THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO (No. 2) 1942.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2074.

MADE UNDER SECTION 78.

Whereas at a meeting of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta held on the 8th February, 1943, it was decided by the requisite majority of the members of the Council to sell the strip of land described in the Schedule hereto and registered in the name of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta (hereinafter referred to as "the land") to the Government of the Colony for the sum of £2:

Now, therefore, I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 78 of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to (No. 2) 1942, do hereby sanction the sale of the land by the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta to the Government of the Colony for the sum of £2.

SCHEDULE:

The strip of land 2,592 square feet in extent (marked green on the plan at red 12A in C.S.M.P. 1199/38), being a portion of plot No. 225 of Government Survey Plan XXXIII.13.I.III and registered in the name of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta.
