THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO (No. 2) 1943.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF NICOSIA.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to (No. 2) 1943, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Nicosia hereby make the following bye-laws:-

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Nicosia Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1944 and shall be read as one with the Nicosia (Principal and Amended) Bye-laws, 1938 to (No. 2) 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Nicosia Municipal

Bye-laws, 1938 to 1944. 2. Paragraph (1) of bye-law 202 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended as follows :-

(a) by the deletion in the second line thereof of the words "one piastre" and the substitution therefor of the words "two piastres";

(b) by the deletion in the third line thereof of the words "half a piastre" and the substitution therefor of the words "one piastre".

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor. (M.P. 1424/12/6.)
