THE CYPRUS VOLUNTEER FORCE LAWS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1941, AS AMENDED BY THE AMENDMENT OF THE CYPRUS VOLUNTEER FORCE LAWS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1941, (DEFENCE) REGULATIONS, 1942.

PROCLAMATION MADE UNDER SECTION 11A.

Governor.

Whereas by section 11A of the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, as amended by the Amendment of the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, (Defence) Regulations, 1942, it is enacted that the Governor may, by Proclamation, call out and mobilize the Force or any part thereof for actual service whenever it appears advisable to do so:

And whereas it appeared advisable to call out and mobilize the Reserve Workshop Company of the Cyprus Volunteer Force:

And whereas the aforesaid Company was, by a Proclamation published in the $\it Gazette$ of the 20th March, 1944, called out and mobilized:

And whereas I deem it necessary and expedient to demobilize the aforesaid Company:

Now, therefore, I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 11a of the said Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, as amended by the Amendment of the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, (Defence) Regulations, 1942, and of every other power hereunto enabling, do hereby, by this Proclamation, demobilize, all the officers and other ranks of the aforesaid Company whose names and particulars are set out in the Schedule hereto:
