

No. 136. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1944.

THE CONTROL OF CATTLE AND MEAT ORDERS, 1942.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by clause 6 of the Control of Cattle and Meat Orders, 1942, I hereby prescribe that during the period between the 12th April, 1944 and the 16th April, 1944, the Mukhtar of any village may issue permits for the slaughter of cattle sufficient to provide, in addition to the usual quantity of 50 drams, a further quantity of 50 drams of carcass weight in respect of each Christian or non-Moslem inhabitant of the village.

No. 137. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1944.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to 1944, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Newsprint Control) (Amendment) Order, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Newsprint Control) Orders, 1940 and 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Newsprint Control) Orders, 1940 to 1944.

2. Clause 6 of the principal Order is hereby deleted and the following clause substituted therefor:—

"6. Not later than twelve days after the last day of each month—

(a) every newspaper proprietor shall complete and deliver to me, at Nicosia, a separate return in the form set forth in the First Schedule hereto containing the particulars therein mentioned in respect of his current stock of newsprint and of the consumption of newsprint for the printing of each and every newspaper of which he is the proprietor;

(b) every person, other than a newspaper proprietor, who has in his possession or under his control any newsprint shall complete and deliver to me, at Nicosia, a return in the form of, and containing the particulars set out in, the Second Schedule hereto."

3. The heading of the Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the word "FIRST" immediately before the word "SCHEDULE".

4. The principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein after the First Schedule of the following Schedule:—

"SECOND SCHEDULE.

The Defence (Newsprint Control) Orders, 1940 to 1944—(Clause 6(b)).
