ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to 1944, I hereby order as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Stationery Control) (Amendment) Order, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Stationery Control) Order, 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Stationery Control) Orders, 1944.

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after clause 4 of the following clause:—

"4A.—(1) From and after the 13th day of April, 1944, no person shall sell,

purchase, dispose of, make use of or deal with any stationery except under a special permit issued under my hand.

(2) Every special permit issued under paragraph (1) of this clause may contain such terms, limitations and conditions (including the price at which the stationery may be sold, purchased or disposed of) as may be specified therein."

3. Clause 7 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after paragraph (c) of the following paragraph:-

"(d) fails to comply with any term, limitation or condition in any permit issued under this Order;"
