THE FOREST REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1942.

NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 6.

It is hereby notified for general information that in virtue of the authority vested in him by regulation 6 of the Forest Regulations, 1940 to 1942, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to declare that the Minor State Forests, the areas of which are set out in the Schedule to the Minor State Forests (Nicosia, Kyrenia and Paphos) Orders, 1942 to 1944, shall be reserved as Village Fuel Areas.

2. The notice published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 9th December, 1943, under Notification No. 456, is hereby cancelled without prejudice to anything done thereunder.

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1943.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF LIMASSOL.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1943, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol hereby make the following bye-laws:—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1944.

2. Bye-law 161 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby repealed and the following bye-law substituted therefor:—

"161.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person obtaining a licence to use within the municipal limits any theatre for any purpose and any building or tent for the performance of any stage-play or cinematograph exhibition or for dancing or for any entertainment to which the public is admitted or for any public meeting, that is to say:—

| (d) For a period of one week a fee, to be determined in each case by the Council, not exceeding | | 60 |
| (e) For a single performance a fee, to be determined in each case by the Council, not exceeding | | 10 |

(2) Every such fee shall be paid to the town clerk and treasurer."

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor.
