## THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1944.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to 1944, I hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Anari Control) Order, 1944.

2. For the purposes of this Order-

" anari " means the type of locally manufactured cheese known as anari.

3.—(1) From and after the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* no person shall consume, make use of, sell or otherwise dispose of any anari in quantities exceeding 15 okes at any one time or at any single transaction, except under a permit in writing issued under my hand.

(2) Every permit issued under this clause may contain such terms, limitations and conditions (including the price at which the anari may be sold or disposed of) as may be specified therein.

4. Not later than three days after the last day of every month, commencing from the month of April, 1944, every person who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of anari in excess of 15 okes shall complete and deliver to me a return in the form of, and containing the particulars set out in, the Schedule hereto.

5. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made under the provisions of this Order.

6. Any person who-

- (a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order;
- (b) fails to comply with any term, limitation or condition in any permit issued under this Order;
- (c) makes any return under this Order which is false in any material particular;
- (d) knowingly misleads or otherwise interferes with or impedes any person exercising any powers or performing any duties under this Order;

is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulations 61 and 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to 1944.
