

No. 15. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1943.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Stationery Control) Order, 1944.
 2. In this Order—
“Stationery” means any article set out in the second column of the First Schedule to this Order.
 3. Within three days from the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* every person who has in his possession or under his control any stationery in excess of the quantity specified in the third column of the First Schedule hereto shall complete and deliver to me a return in the form set forth in the Second Schedule hereto in respect of the stationery in his possession or under his control.
 4. Not later than 6 days after the last day of every month, commencing from the month of February, 1944, any person who has in his possession or under his control any stationery in excess of the quantity specified in the third column of the First Schedule hereto shall complete and deliver to me a return containing the particulars set forth in the Third Schedule hereto in respect of his dealings in stationery.
 5. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner may authorize in writing in that behalf to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under any of the provisions of this Order.
 6. The First Schedule hereto may be amended by me by Notice published in the *Gazette* and upon such publication such amendment shall form part of this Order for all purposes.
 7. Any person who—
(a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order ;
(b) makes, under the provisions of this Order, any return which is false in any material particular ;
(c) knowingly misleads or otherwise interferes with or impedes any person exercising any powers or performing any duties under the provisions of this Order ;
- is liable to the penalties proscribed in the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943.

THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF FUEL AND CHARCOAL) ORDERS, 1943.

NOTICE NO. 3 UNDER CLAUSE 10.

The Third Schedule to the Defence (Control of Fuel and Charcoal) Orders, 1943, is hereby amended as follows :—

1. By the deletion from column (2) of the part of the Third Schedule relating to Fuelwood of the figure " 35 " set below the words " Paras per oke " and the figure " 77 " set below the words " Shillings per cord " relating to Limassol Town and the substitution thereof of the figures " 30 " and " 66 ", respectively.

2. By the deletion from the part of the Third Schedule relating to Charcoal of the figure " 80 " set out opposite the words " Villages where charcoal is manufactured " in item 2 (relating to Limassol District) and in item 3 (relating to Paphos District) and the substitution thereof of the figure " 90 " in each case.
