No. 153. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1944.

Delegation of Power under Paragraph (5) of Regulation 66.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph (5) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to 1944, and of every other power hereunto enabling, do hereby order as follows:—

(relating to delegation of powers) is hereby further amended by the insertion therein immediately after the figure and words "6. Senior Stock Inspectors", which appear in the second column of the said Schedule, of the figure and words "6A. Deputy Controller of Agricultural Purchases".

LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1944.

Notice is hereby given that the following lands namely THAT portion of plot No. 226, Block A, Ibrahim Pasha Quarter, Nicosia, situated between the Neapolis locality, the Government of Cyprus Railway and the road from Nicosia to the village of Trakhonas, demarcated by white cairns numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 9, 10 and 11 are required by the Governor for an undertaking of public utility.
