A PROCLAMATION.

C. C. WOOLLEY,
Governor.

Whereas it is expedient that the village of Makheras, in the District of Nicosia, should be abolished:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby proclaim that the village of Makheras in the District of Nicosia shall, for all administrative purposes, be abolished as from the 1st day of July, 1944, and that the whole of the present area of the said village shall be transferred to Lazania village in the District of Nicosia and shall form one common area of the said village of Lazania as from the said date.

Given at Nicosia, this 31st day of May, 1944.

THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2121

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1944. *Gazette:*

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to "CAMEROONS (b) French Sphere", "DAHOMEY", "FRENCH CONGO", "FRENCH GUINEA" and "IVORY COAST" under the heading "SERVICE PARTIALLY BY AIR AND PARTIALLY BY SURFACE ROUTE";
