No. 205. THE CUSTOMS (EXPORT DUTY) LAW, 1940
AND
THE CUSTOMS (EXPORT DUTY) LAW, 1940 (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS,
1943.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2124

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940, as amended by the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940 (Amendment) Regulations, 1943, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Export Duty) Schedule Amendment Order, 1944.

2. The Schedule to the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940, is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the insertion therein immediately after item 6 of the following item:—
“ 7. Raisins 10 per centum *ad valorem*.”
- (b) by the deletion therefrom of items 8 and 8A and the substitution thereof of the following items, respectively:—
“ 8. Spirits 20 per centum *ad valorem*.
8A. Wines 15 per centum *ad valorem*.”

3. The Customs (Export Duty) Schedule Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1943, is hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

No. 206. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1944.
