THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2132

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

C. C. WOOLLEY, Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage No. 2) (Amendment) Order, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Air Mail Gazette: Rate of Postage No. 2) Order, 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), Supplement and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office No. 3: (Air Mail Rate of Postage No. 2) Orders, 1944. (Air Mail Rate of Postage No. 2) Orders, 1944.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order, is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to "GIBRALTAR", "PORTUGAL" and "SPAIN" under the heading "SERVICE BY AIR THROUGHOUT" and the substitution therefor of the following entries, respectively:
