(1) When kerosene is sold in bulk or by the oke ex sealed tin, without the tin, the price shall be that shown in column (2) above, calculated on the net weight of the kerosene.

(2) When kerosene is sold in sealed tins, with the tin, the purchaser shall have

the option of buying (a) by weight or (b) by the tin.

If he elects to buy by weight, the price shall be that shown in column (2) above calculated on the net weight of the kerosene contained in the tin and for the purpose of such calculation the tin shall be deemed to weigh one oke. If he elects to buy by the tin, the price shall be that shown in column (3) above."
